The repeater fund stands at \$3,921.89. Club membership stands at 54 with 4 lifetime and 50 dues paying. We had 21 at the October meeting with 19 members and 2 guests.

ARRL/PIO: N4DOU advised us that N4JJ, Jack Jackson, has resigned as Assistant Section Manager. We are pleased that our returning member, KF2X, Craig England will assume that position. Thank you Jack for all of your service and we know that

Craig will do an excellent job.

Repeaters: Both the 97 and the 440 repeaters are working properly, however, the 85 had a problem with the PA. We have temporarily replaced the repeater with the old Sprecum and have shipped the MASTR III up to Lynchburg, VA. for repairs and parts through our former member NN4RB, Rick Brown. Since we need to spend some money on repairs and parts, there was a discussion about what authorization is necessary to release club funds. KF2X let us know that when the Constitution was written, funds could be released with the approval of the three officers acting as a Business Committee. Both W4YLX, Rudolph and K4AVR, Mac, were then authorized to spend reasonable funds as necessary for repairs and replacement parts.
